

Jump, Frog, Jump Craft Activity

Materials needed: Clothespin Scissors
 Frog pattern shown below Glue

Instructions:

1. Print and cut out the frog pattern shown below. (Figure 1)
2. Cut the frog into two pieces along the solid line.
3. Using the glue, attach the top and bottom of the frog's body to the clothespin and allow glue to dry.
4. Holding the end of the clothespin, your child can open and close the frog's mouth. (Figure 2)

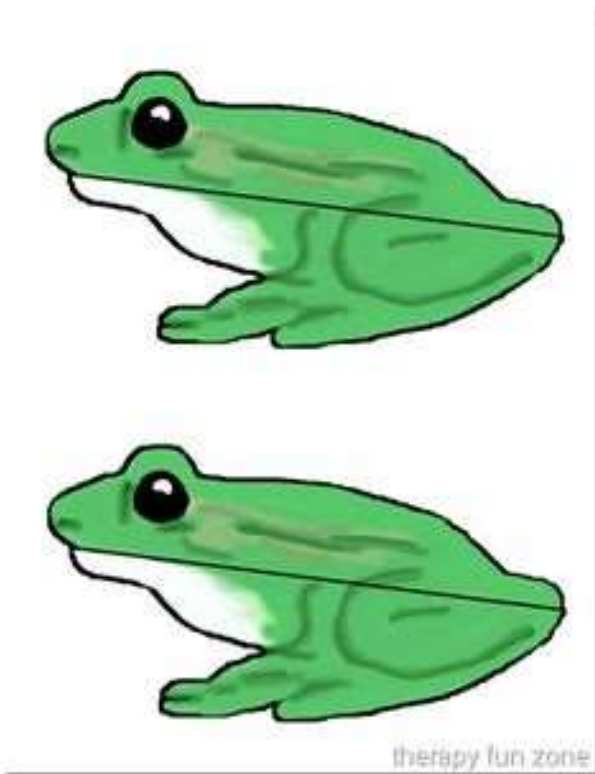
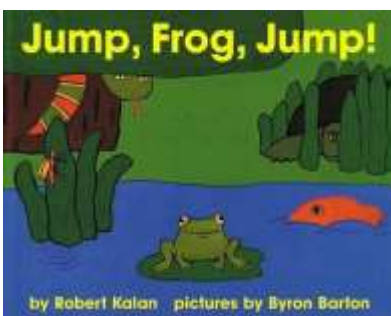
